



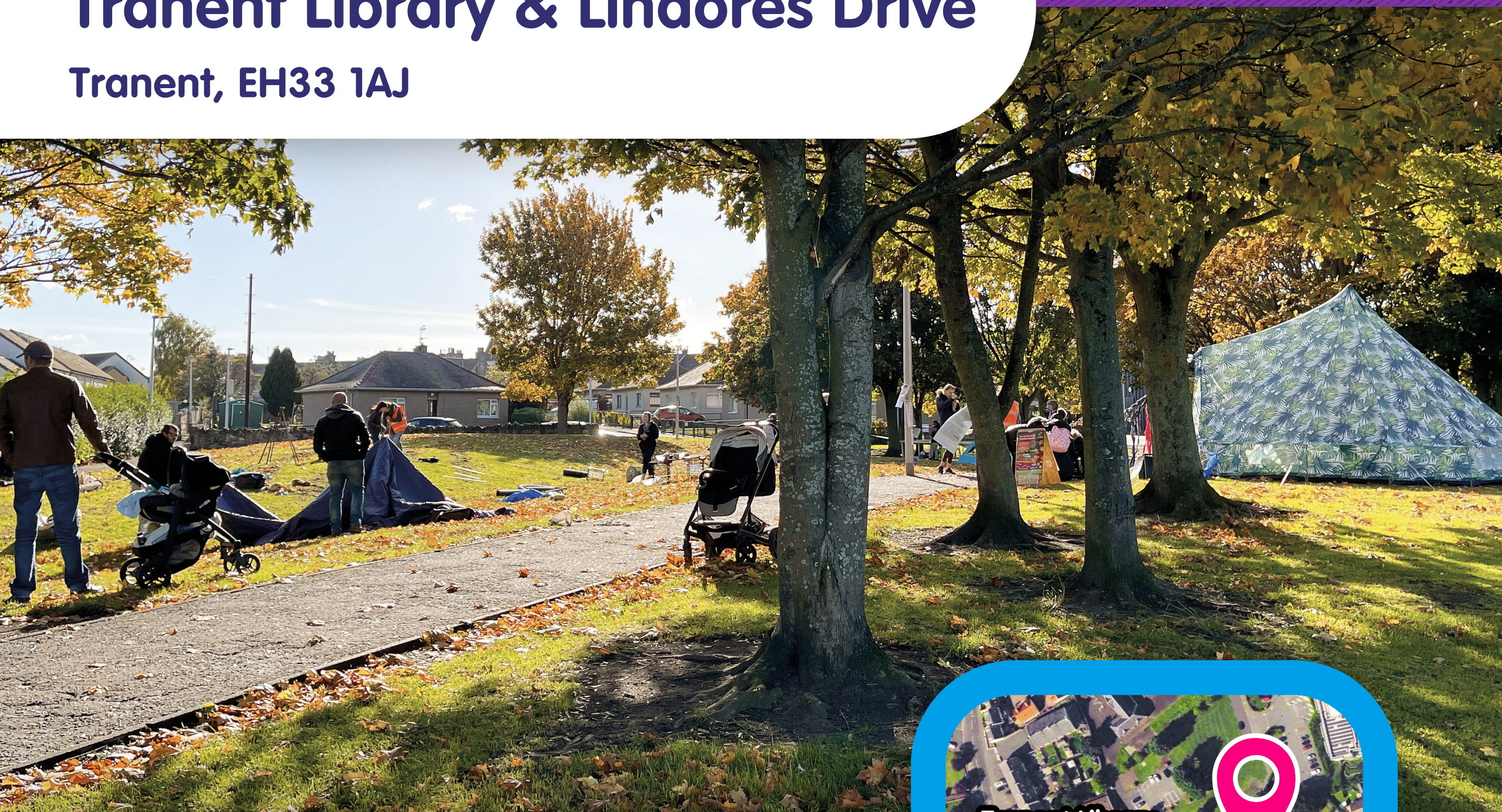

Parking

There is a medium-sized car park beside the space and a smaller one just outside The Fraser Centre.

90 minutes maximum stay may apply.

Long-stay parking is available further along Lindores Drive at Foresters Park. There is also on-street parking with disabled parking bays nearby.

Public Transport

Lothian Buses, East Coast Buses and Prentice Coaches run buses to Tranent. We recommend Traveline Scotland for up-to-date information. **www.travelinescotland.com**

The space is a few minutes' walk from the nearest bus stops.

Toilets

Public toilets are available along Lindores Drive just across the road from The Fraser Centre. There are accessible toilets in The Fraser Centre.

Wheelchair Access

The green space has a wide path running through it. The Fraser Centre is a modern, accessible building.

Seating and Benches

There is no seating available in the space but our team will have a couple of folding chairs available. There is seating in the café area of The Fraser Centre.

Things to be aware of

- Children should be accompanied by an adult unless they are able to come and go from the space on their own.
- The space is open to members of the public, who may have dogs with them.
- One edge of the space opens onto a busy road at Lindores Drive. Our activities will be based further up the space away from this road.
- There is a busy road between the green space and The Fraser Centre. Please be careful when crossing the road.
- The Fraser Centre café may be open while our activities are running. It is economically priced and has a nice range of drinks, snacks and meals. The café is open to the public.

Resources

We will have a range of exciting play resources including things like a 'loose parts' play kit, den building equipment, hammocks, parachutes, pots & pans, sensory resources, chalk and usually some shelters. Our team will be at the space to welcome you, and to support and facilitate play!
